All seats will be sold on a first-come, first-served basis and all sales will be cash or check. Ticket sales will begin November 9th and 10th for East Texas State University students; November 11th for East Texas State faculty/staff; and November 12th for the general public. Tickets are \$12.00 for the general public and \$10.00 for East Texas State University Students. Each student must present his ID and may purchase no more than two tickets. A student may then purchase the six remaining seats at his table for the regular price.

Please be certain as to the number of your party, as there will be no refunds or exchanges. Sale hours are from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday at the Student Activities Center located on the second floor of the Sam Rayburn Memorial Student Center.
