When you became a conductor of the new Glenn Miller Orchestra, I believed that I will be able to meet you again sometime in the future, but I did not expect that it would be realized so soon.


It is still like a dream for me that I can meet you and your wife as well next month, and I am most anxiously awaiting for your arrival here by counting the time on fingers.
