ETSU "ROUSER WEEK" TO
FEATURE GRAND PRIX

COMMERCE, --To help students recover from the doldrums brought on by lazy spring days, the Inter-Residence Hall Council at East Texas State University will sponsor "Resident Rouser Week" April 16-20.

This year's "Rouser Week" will feature a "dessert theater," a carnival, a dance and will be climaxed with the fifth annual Go-Gart Grand Prix.

The 125-lap, 45-mile race will be held April 20 (Thursday) in the commuter parking lot south of the Music Building.

Thursday's activities will begin with the Miss Grand Prix swimsuit contest at 2:45 p.m. followed by a one-lap women's tricycle race at 3 p.m.

The go-cart race will begin at 3:30 p.m. All three events are open to the public without charge.

Winners in the go-cart race, which is limited to carts with engines of 6.1 cubic inches and 10 horsepower or less, will receive trophies and cash prizes of \$25, \$15 and \$10 for the top three finishers.

First, second and third place trophies will be presented in the Miss Grand Prix contest. A first place trophy will be awarded the winning four-woman team in the tricycle race and a \$5 prize will be presented to the team with the "most far-out costume."

The schedule for other "Rouser Week" events is as follows: Sunday, April 16 at 7 p.m.--"The Dessert Theater" in Central Cafeteria; Monday, April 17 at 7 p.m.--Carnival; Tuesday, April 18 at 8 p.m.--Street Dance at West Halls parking lot.
