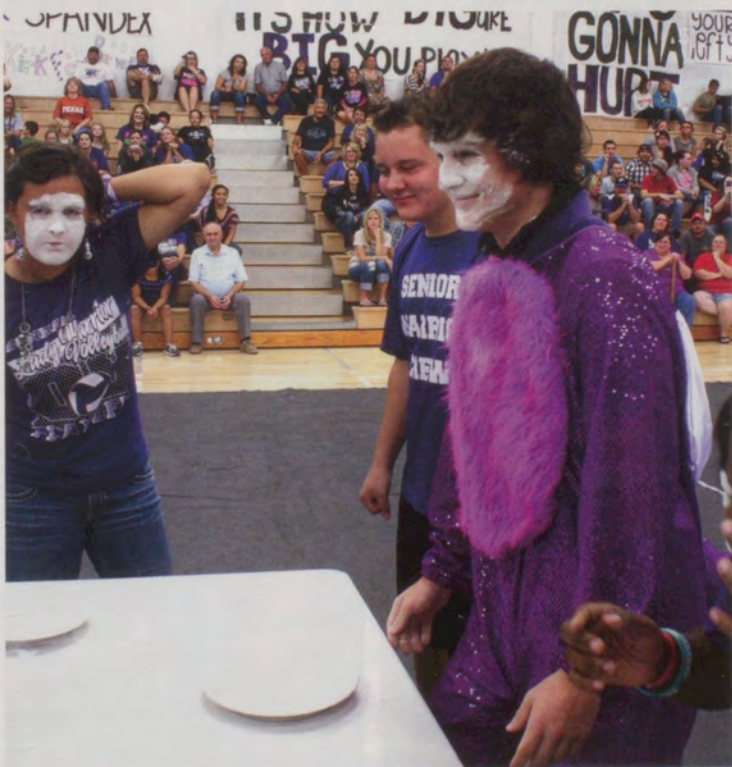

Senator Deuell Addresses Crowd At Bonham Academic Excellence Awards Stressing Importance of Education

"You can't go anywhere without an education," said Senator Bob Deuell. "The quality of life you have in the future depends upon the education you receive now."

He addressed the crowd assembled in the gymnasium on Nov. 14, 2011, for the annual Bonham Academic Excellence Awards. During his speech, Senator Deuell stressed the importance of getting an education and especially the need for seniors to attend college.

There were 137 students who received a purple stadium blanket or a patch for their excellent grades during the previous school year. Students must maintain a 4.0 GPA or above throughout the full year of academics to be eligible.

The awards program was coordinated by the Bonham Education Foundation, Inc., as a community project to encourage academic excellence in the schools by rewarding BHS students who have demonstrated consistent and outstanding academic achievements. Welcoming the crowd was Steve Mohundro, treasurer, of the BEF, Inc. He also recognized the committee and sponsors of this year's program. Monica Kissling, secretary for the BEF, Inc. then introduced guest speaker, Senator Deuell.

Presentation of the awards was done by Superintendent Sonny Cruse and Curriculum Director Ricky Gatlin.

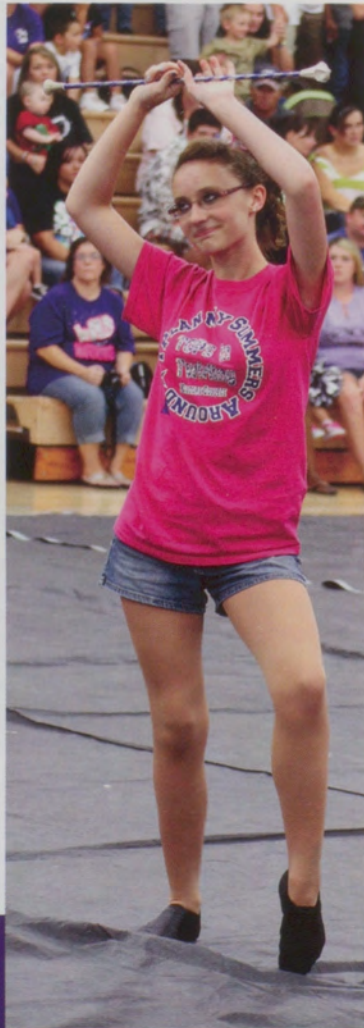

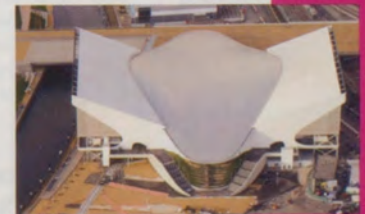
