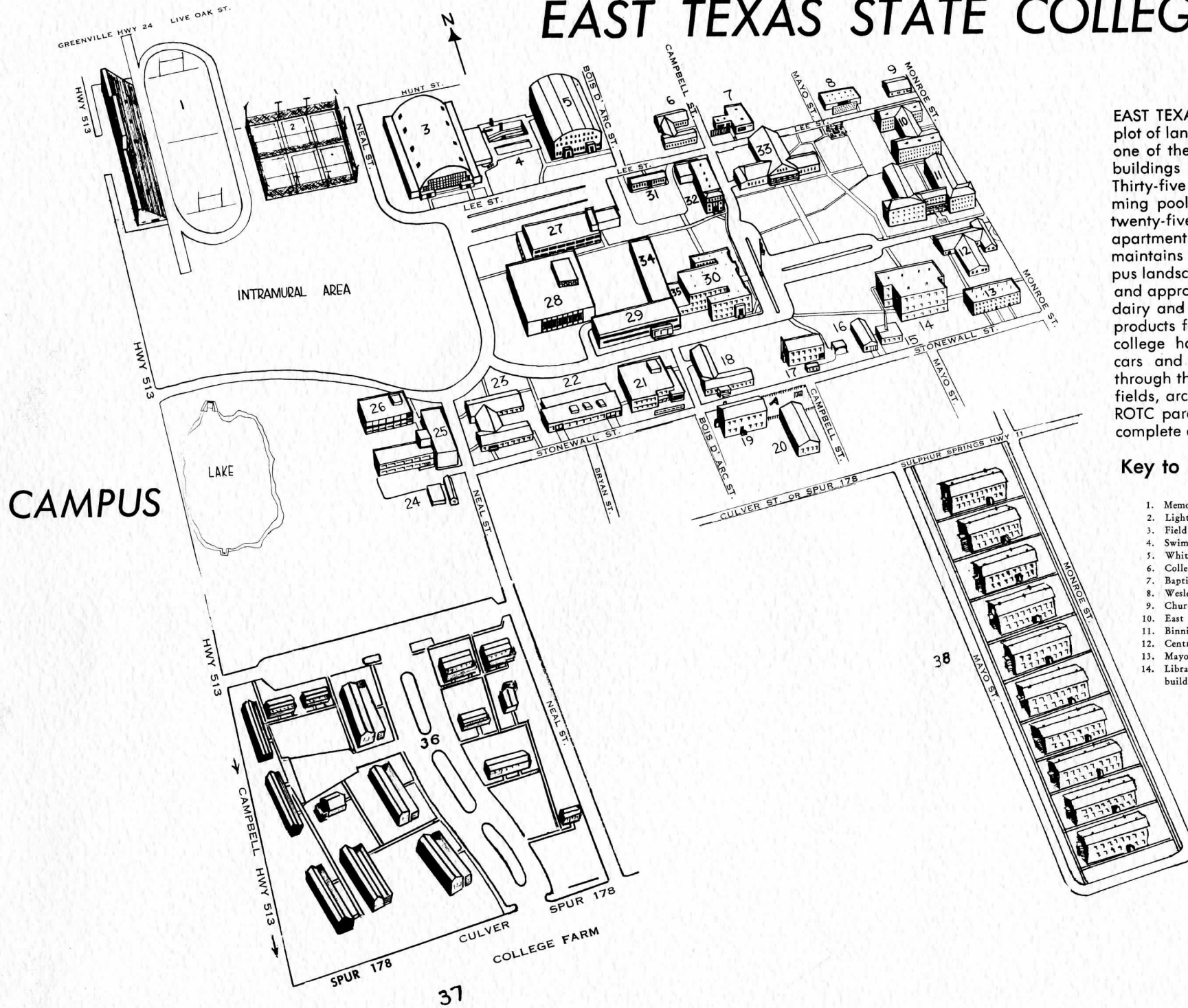
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EAST TEXAS STATE COLLEGE COMMERCE, TEXAS



EAST TEXAS STATE COLLEGE is located on a 100-acre plot of land in the southwest corner of Commerce. It is one of the most beautiful campuses in the state with buildings arranged in groups according to function. Thirty-five buildings, including the stadium and swimming pool, make up the main campus, and another twenty-five farm buildings, and 192 married student apartments are located off the campus. The college maintains its own water system, greenhouse for campus landscaping, and has a picnic ground, rodeo arena and approximately 500 acres of farm land. A modern dairy and meat packing plant furnish milk and meat products for student use in the college cafeteria. The college has parking facilities for over two thousand cars and over one mile of paved drives winding through the campus. Lighted tennis courts, intramural fields, archery range, rifle range, swimming pool and ROTC parade ground are parts of East Texas State's complete campus.
