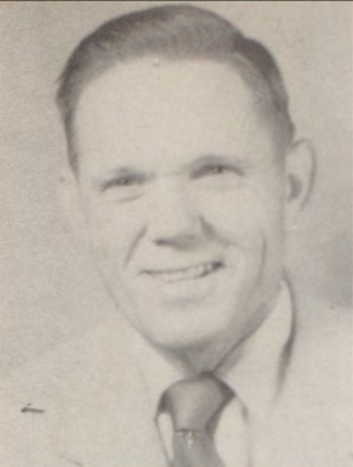
We have shared eleven happy years in Bonham Schools with many of you. Certainly our best wishes will be with you and those who have joined our group from time to time.
