FIRST AID CLASS OPENED AUG 3
1942

A Red Cross First Aid course will be offered beginning Tuesday night, December 2, at 7:00 P.M. at the Fire Station on Pecan Street. This course will be taught by a registered First Aid Instructor sent out by the Highway Safety Department. The class will meet from 7 to 9 o'clock each Tuesday and Thursday evenings, except during the Christmas holidays until the class has met for twenty hours. Members who pass the course are entitled to a Red Cross Certificate in First Aid.
