Faculty Members:

In two weeks we shall send out our fourth News Letter to ET men and women in the Services. Our last letter brought in nearly a hundred replies from interested and satisfied customers.

Addresses change so rapidly that I am forced into a complete overhauling of my card indexed file; thus will you place in my box all names and addresses that you know--regardless of whether you have given me these before?

Furthermore, will you ask the students of each of your classes for the same information; furnish me with the latest addresses of faculty members and the sons and daughters of faculty members in the Services, and of your neighbors' sons and daughters?

College and town clubs sometimes, too, can furnish this information. I ask sponsors and members of such organizations to get as many names and addresses from these sources as they can.
