ETSU FOREIGN LANGUAGES DEPT.
OFFERING STUDY IN FRANCE

COMMERCE, --Two scholarships are available for study in France during 1972-73, the East Texas State University Department of Foreign Languages announced this week.

Dr. Harold L. Simpson, head of the foreign languages department, explained that the first scholarship, Concours Bordas, is a full academic year grant of 10,000 francs (approximately \$2,500), while the second is the Third International University Summer School at the National Institute of Public Education at Marly-Le-Roi (socio-educational and cultural fields).

Specialization in foreign language is not necessary although a knowledge of French is a prerequisite. Age limitations are from 17-21 years of age for the Bordas and 23-45 for the Marly-Le-Roi.
