Dr. Sawyer to speak

ETSU HISTORY PROFESSOR TO
ADDRESS GREENVILLE KIWANIANS

COMMERCE --Dr. William E. Sawyer, East Texas State University history faculty, will speak to the Greenville Kiwanis Club Tuesday (March 7) on the subject "Martin Hart, Civil War G^errilla."

According to Dr. Sawyer, Hart was a leader in Greenville when the Civil War broke out. When he left for the war he was a Confederate officer, but he later became a Union Army officer in Arkana^sas.

Dr. Sawyer will relate the story of how Hart came to be buried in the National Cemetery at Fort Smith.

A writer of historic articles, Dr. Sawyer has had articles published in "The East Texas Historical Quarterly," "Texana" and "The Arkana^sas Historical Quarterly." He is currently writing a history of East Texas State University.
