TOPICS SET FOR ETSU
RELATED SUBJECTS SERIES

COMMERCE, --The Inter-Residence Hall Council at East Texas State University will sponsor two "coed living" discussions, a discussion of sex-related topics and a program on liquor-politics beginning Monday (March 6) on the ETSU campus.

The Program is called the Related Subjects Series and is held once each semester to enable ETSU students to discuss topics of interest with administrators and local citizens whom they would not normally come in contact with.

The first "coed living" discussion will be held at 7:30 p.m. Monday (March 6) at Smith Hall. Dr. John J. Koldus, vice president of ETSU Student Affairs, will be the guest speaker.

Mike Ewell, ETSU student body vice president, and Ron Daloia, administrative assistant to the ETSU student body president, will be guest speakers at the liquor-politics discussion. The program will be held at 7:30 p.m. Tuesday (March 7) in the Whitley Hall lounge.

At 7:30 p.m. Wednesday (March 8), Sikes Hall will host Dr. James E. Nicholson, Greenville physician, for a discussion on sex-related topics.

The final "coed living" discussion will be held at 8 p.m. (March 9) at Binnion Hall. A panel discussion will be held with panel members, Dr. H. Don Pope, ETSU housing director; Dorothy LeMole, ETSU coordinator of women's housing; Dr. Robert Butler, ETSU dean of student activities; and ETSU Dean of Women Janice King.
