## ETSU FRATERNITY TO HOST LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE

COMMERCE, --The Texas Zeta Chapter of Sigma Phi Epsilon, social fraternity, at East Texas State University will host the 1972 Regional Academy here March 24-26 (Friday-Sunday).

The academy, a leadership training conference, is being held in seven different locations this spring. The ETSU chapter will host 30 chapters from the Southwest Region which includes Mississippi, Arkansas, Louisiana, Oklahoma, western Tennessee and Texas.

According to David Robison, coordinator of the academy, around 175 newly-elected chapter executive board officials and counselors are expected to attend a training conference.

The three-day meeting will feature a banquet Saturday night with guest speaker Dr. Duncan Wimpres, president of Trinity University.

Special guests at the banquet will be two members of the Sigma Phi Epsilon National Board of Directors, Jack Wheeler and John Hartman; two representatives from Sigma Phi Epsilon Staff Headquarters, Don Tanner and Don McCleary; ETSU Assistant Dean of Men Jack Lassiter; and ETSU Student Senate President Mike Ewell.

Topics to be covered in the meetings that will be held throughout the conference are membership recruitment, membership education, chapter communication and financial responsibility.

Housing for the delegates will be at Berry Hall on the ETSU campus.
