## TWO ETSU STUDENTS RECEIVE NSF GRANTS

COMMERCE, --Two senior science students at East Texas State University have been awarded graduate fellowships of \$3,600 per year by the National Science Foundation (NSF), according to an announcement made today (March 21) by U. S. Representative Ray Roberts.

Connie H. Miller, a biology major from Shalimar, Fla., was awarded an NSF grant to study genetics at the University of California, San Diego. Bryan L. Bartlett, a chemistry major from Commerce, received a grant to study inorganic chemistry at the University of Texas at Austin.

The NSF will also award a \$3,000 grant to each of the institutions the ETSU students will attend for graduate study.
