ETSU CONTINUING EDUCATION TO OFFER
COURSE FOR SWIMMING POOL OPERATORS

COMMERCE, --A short course for anyone interested in proper swimming pool sanitation and operation will be conducted here May 17 (Wednesday).

The one-day course--slated to begin at 9 a.m. in the Goliad and Velasco Rooms of East Texas State University's student center--is sponsored by ETSU's Division of Continuing Education in conjunction with the Texas State Department of Health and Texas' Beach and Pool Association.

Included in the day's events will be lectures and presentations on pool sanitation, algae control, bacteriology, water disinfection, pool safety, filters and recirculation equipment.

Municipal, motel, country club, and private swimming pool owners and operators, health officers and public health personnel, recreation department personnel, and all others interested in proper swimming pool sanitation and operation are invited to attend, said Mrs. Pat Turner, program coordinator for continuing education.

An examination covering the material presented in the program will be given at 2:45 p.m. for all who desire to take it. Persons who attain a passing grade of 75 will be issued a certificate of completion. The certificates do not have to be renewed.
