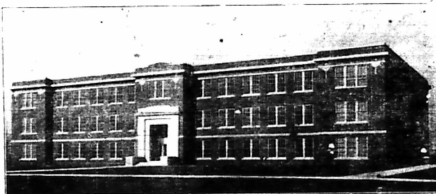


East Texas State Teachers College

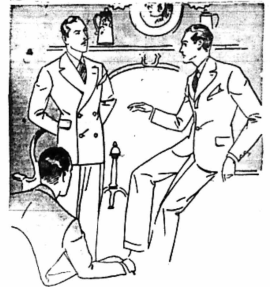
