Who put thrill in the word "adventurer"? And who also loves it as youth? The spirit of adventure has characterized the pursuit of knowledge in all ages and has resulted in science having often been the result of "adventure" rather than the result of "science" between nations.

It isn't probable that one generation will give to the world many men who can duplicate the achievements of the past or others equally as great, but it is possible for all of us to get satisfaction out of our pursuit of knowledge; and it is quite probable that some of us in the course of time will make original contributions to the knowledge of the world. It is not to know that the spirit of adventure in science is not confined to the researcher in search of new learning. All knowledge in this world is being acquired it is not an inborn talent. Would you not say it is indeed an inborn intellect that does not get a thrill of satisfaction out of such a pursuit and conquest?

It is said that the youth of today goes forth to appropriate two worlds—the spiritual world and the mechanical world. It is rather easy to see why young people may get a thrill out of the mechanical world, what we call science, automobiles, airplanes and the like that supply plenty of thrills to test the nerve and tax the capacity of the most daring of our youth. But it isn't so easy to get thrills from the spiritual world, the world of knowledge and learning. But the satisfaction of either is as real as the other. Remember that truth is often elusive. A law of nature, a fact of history, a mathematical problem or the meaning of a poem may hide and need with one for hours; but to the true sportsman, conquest is certain, and the resulting satisfaction from the pursuit is usually proportional to the effort expended. There's no free lunch.

Modern educators are realizing that college is not a preparatory course for life; it is life. A student's life is as much a progress as when he enters college as when he leaves it. It is realized that a new day for the student is coming—a day when he will find joy that thrills him in discovering and in selecting from the curriculum those courses which will develop his own nature, capacities, quite as much as basketball or football. This is a step in progressive education that will be welcomed by every student. With it will come a keener zest in the adventure of learning.

It is true that college life has its personal, moral, and intellectual hazards. Some who enter the higher institutions of learning find the difference too great to overcome. Probably they failed to grasp the spirit of adventure. There are others who come to college with a background of intellectual interest and an objective outlook, and a real of their efforts. They are ready to try to realize that the intellectual involves high adventures, and that while the progress will not always be easy nor do work of disproportionate time and effort are commensurate and possible, the rewards are abundant. To them there are thrills a-plenty while adventuring in learning.

The challenge of college life today is to seek and win what you can from the spirit of adventure, the spirit of knowledge. Can WE accept the challenge?
