"The country should provide education good enough for the best, and cheap enough for the poorest." These are the words of Henry Barnard, First United States Commissioner of Education. East Texas State believes that no one has ever spoken words more full of truth.

But whether or not any one had said so, that still would have been the philosophy of this institution. East Texas college has always been known far and wide for its economy. As a private institution and then as a state supported school it has always offered education at the highest price that has ever been paid for it. It is shown that in 1934-35 East Texas offered education at a lower price than any other state supported school of college. A statistician's figures show that for 1935-36 only one other state school reduced its figures lower than did our college—it did it only by four cents per credit hour. This, all institutions still, all other than the state colleges in lowest education rates, yet let it be remembered that the quality of education is not been sacrificed. All requirements are met and the quality of all higher standards have been carefully observed.

**Carnegie's "Able" Camouflage**
