## Second Minor in Journalism Now Available at Elex

By offering two more courses in journalism, the college is now making a second minor in journalism possible. This consists of four semesters with twelve hours.

English 313, news editing, was offered last year. English 312 is a new course in editorial writing. According to the instructor, John Hart, the course will employ the latest methods. "The Editorial Page" by E. J. Jones. The plan calls for the preparation of a dummy editorial, once each week, the writing of an editorial weekly, and work on the history of journalism.
