Million-Dollar Budget INCREASE ASKED BY TEXAS' SEVEN TEACHER COLLEGES FOR NEXT BIENNIIUM

East Texas State Teachers College has asked for more than a million dollar increase in its budget for the next two years, it was reported in Austin, Tex. week, including all the State schools, an increase of six million dollars has been asked for the South end of the building.

East Texas State set its budget at \$200,000, an increase of \$750,000 with this increase only four weeks ago. The new budget appropriations had been made by the State Teachers College, San Antonio, \$871,000; San Marcos, \$520,000; Sul Ross, \$371,000; Clayton, \$260,000; and Del Rio, \$160,000.

The appropriation for the four State schools is \$1,600,000 for the entire year, an increase of \$1,000,000 over the present year.
