HAS JUSTICE STUMBED?

If Henrik Hansen, "Ghosts," was to be presented in Leeds, England, or indeed in any other city of the British Isles today, doubtless there would be something of an outburst of sentiment against an English court, which gave the sentence of death to a man and a woman who had murdered their baby. Even without a plea, there is a growing feeling of sympathy for the little old woman who feared that her tubercle son would not be cared for after her death, which she felt was never a day away.

The story was brought out in the trial, that for the last thirty years she had been vigilantly nursing her invalid son. Not long ago she was, taking that index she used as a dangerous weapon, she could not live more than six months. Fearing that she would see the son she loved, gave him a hundred dollars' value, and intended to give it to her husband, who had said that he would take the family doctor that she had just put Denko to sleep."

Throughout the trial she remained brave, calmly continuing to maintain that she "did it in mercy." Her head was bowed and she refused the sentence of death, pronounced by the judge. Many a person in the courtroom could not keep back tears. Doubtless many others, who read of the trial, also were deeply moved.

"Why? Because, in the lack of people's minds, there is the thought that perhaps justice was just a little blind in this instance. True, we believe that murderers should be severely punished. Nothing is to be served for a man who willfully and maliciously kills a fellow being. But who can tell the emotions that might have stirred deep in the heart of the old mother as she knew she was sending "her son to hell?"

Surely she loved him. No mother would have nursed a child so devotedly for thirty years without loving him. She must have labored for long hours in watching out and caring for her pitiful offspring. Perhaps many times at night she prayed endlessly that her son's affliction might be taken from him, and perhaps she cried silently as the doctors would tell her repeatedly, that there was no cure.

She, who had her own life, took from him the trouble, dimly felt, half-light that was his, and in exchange sent him out into that unknown world where there is hope of life everlasting. In doing so she felt that within a little while she, too, would be able to see him again as, in the years of his babyhood, he would have come to her, and she would be with him before long, that he truly act as at the hands of a court of justice which has favored so far the traitor; but we dare believe that a higher court above will see more than the motives of a woman who did as she felt, and then only, will justice be done.—EDWARD MANGUM.
